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CASA DI CURA ERETENIA

Casa di Cura Eretenia is a private healthcare facility, accredited by the Regional Health Service, which provides the diagnosis and treatment of health conditions requiring admission to hospital, Day Surgery or outpatient diagnostic and therapeutic procedures.

The facility has a total of 105 beds, including 74 beds covered by the national health service (2 of which for postoperative intensive care) divided into **medical functional area**, **general and specialist surgery and rehabilitation area**.

The Clinic has a **medical laboratory**, where all lab tests are performed, except those requiring a high level of specialisation.

The Clinic includes a **Diagnostic Imaging Department**, offering Traditional Radiology, Ultrasound, Senology, CT scans and MRIs.

Medical specialists, general surgeons and surgical specialists follow the clinical and therapeutic guidelines provided by the respective national and international organisations, and are kept up to date by participating in national and international medical conferences.

BASIC PRINCIPLES

EQUALITY

The services offered by the Casa di Cura Eretenia are inspired by the principle of equality and non-discrimination of patients. The facility's rules on patient relationships and access to healthcare services are the same for everyone. Patients will not be discriminated against because of their sex, race, language, religion and political opinions.

Medical care is provided equally to all patients.

Equality should be understood as a prohibition on unjustified discrimination; in particular, Casa di Cura Eretenia has adopted all measures to ensure that all people with disabilities can receive the same healthcare services as other individuals.

IMPARTIALITY

In applying the facility's operational rules, the operators' behaviour is inspired by the principles of objectivity, justice and impartiality.



RIGHT TO CHOOSE

The patient has the right to choose freely and without any moral and material constraints to make use of the services offered by the Clinic, within the limits of the structural, technological and professional requirements offered.

CONTINUITY

Service continuity is assured all days and nights of the year according to the rules governing the facility's activities.

PARTICIPATION

Patients can address any comments and complaints verbally or in writing to the responsible operators (head of department, charge nurse, head of the service or outpatient clinic, medical director, administrative director).

Our operators shall take into account the information reported by the patient and take any necessary measures.

To improve service quality, Casa di Cura Eretenia has established a Public Relations Office as a go-to place for patients who wanted to file claims and complaints, to whom our staff undertakes to reply in writing. In addition, a specific questionnaire is distributed within the facility to evaluate the quality of our service.

EFFICACY AND EFFICIENCY

In providing our healthcare services, we undertake to guarantee constant efficiency and effectiveness. This means that our organisation, in all medical units, aims to meet the needs of patients and to make sure to deliver effective services and procedures.



HEALTH SERVICE ACCESS

Casa di Cura Eretenia provides healthcare services according to the following categories:

ORDINARY HOSPITALISATION

For acute diseases that cannot be treated in an outpatient setting and that require monitoring and assistance by medical and nursing staff;

SAME DAY SURGERY

The procedure does not involve an overnight stay and is performed with local, locoregional or general anaesthesia for invasive and semiinvasive surgical or diagnostic and/or therapeutic procedures;

OUTPATIENT CLINICS

Medical examinations, diagnostic and/ or therapeutic procedures, minor day surgeries that do not require postoperative monitoring.



To save the patient's time, Casa di Cura Eretenia ensures faster procedures for outpatient and diagnosticteststhatarerequired for the patient's admission.

ADMISSIONS

Inpatient services - payment methods:

• COVERED BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE (SPECIAL ARRANGEMENT WITH THE ITALIAN NHS)

The patient does not have to pay any charges, except where he/she wanted to have a private room. Patients are admitted upon submission of a referral by a general practitioner or a licensed specialist and after being examined by our specialist;

PAID SERVICE

The service is billed directly to the patient, who will not be entitled to ask for any total or partial refunds to their local health authority. Before booking the admission, we provide patients a quote for the examinations that will be performed. A GP referral is not required for admissions.

OUTPATIENT SERVICES

The methods of access and treatment described below relate to the health services provided on an outpatient basis:

- Specialist consultations, laboratory tests
- Diagnostic imaging services (X-rays, ultrasound scans, CT scans, MRI)
- Minor surgeries that do not require an overnight stay or postoperative monitoring.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Outpatient services can be accessed with a referral by a general practitioner, a medical specialist, on the patient's initiative or through healthcare assistance programmes.

GENERAL MEDICINE

The General Medicine Department offers treatment for common internal diseases and patients with acute and chronic diseases. Admitted patients can receive NHS or private treatment.

Special attention is devoted to:

- Gastroenterological diseases supported by invasive and non-invasive diagnostic procedures (Endoscopy, Video Laparoscopy, Organ Fine-Needle Aspiration biopsies, Ultrasound, CT scans, MRI, etc.)**
- Acute and chronic cardiovascular diseases, supported by a complete colour Doppler ultrasound diagnostic system
- Lung diseases supported by invasive diagnostic procedures (Endoscopy, Ultrasound or CT-guided biopsy etc.) and non-invasive ones (respiratory tests, etc.)
- Metabolic, endocrine, osteoarticular and neoplastic diseases, for which a pain management consultation service is also provided
- Blood diseases

The Medical Unit also provides the following Services:

- DIGESTIVE ENDOSCOPY **
- ARTERIAL AND VENOUS COLOUR DOPPLER ULTRASOUND EXAM ** of the upper extremities and lower extremities and supra-aortic vessels
- REHABILITATION in-patient treatment with intravenous vasoactive drug therapy with Alprostadil for peripheral artery disease of the lower limbs and chronic pulmonary diseases (including with Continuous Positive Airway Pressure = CPAP)
- INTERNAL MEDICINE CLINIC for metabolic, neoplastic and other diseases of the endocrine, digestive, musculoskeletal, respiratory, cardiovascular systems
- HYPERTENSION CLINIC: diagnosis, therapy, follow up and treatment of any related diseases (diabetes, dyslipidemias, etc.)
- GERIATRICS CLINIC diagnosis and treatment of the most common elderly diseases. Psychogeriatric assessment of dementia
- PNEUMOLOGY CLINIC
- GASTROENTEROLOGY CLINIC
- HAEMATOLOGY CLINIC

The **HAEMATOLOGY** service offers the following specialist services:

- Haematology consultation
- Morphological examination of red blood cells, white blood cells and platelets and diagnosis of blood cell disorders
- Fine needle aspiration sampling of bone marrow and bone marrow biopsy
- Diagnosis of coagulation disorders (haemorrhagic and thrombotic diseases) Iron supplement therapy (intravenous iron for anaemic patients) and anaemia treatment
- Oral and subcutaneous anticoagulant therapy for patients with coagulation disorders
- Service for patients on anticoagulant therapy, with therapeutic, dietary and organisational advice for patients taking drugs such as Coumadin (Warfarin) and Sintrom (Acenocoumarol) and NOACs.
- Blood groups (ABO Rh)
- Specific blood tests including blood count, iron, ferritin, transferrin, transferrin saturation, reticulocytes, vitamin B12, folic acid, erythropoietin, prothrombin time (PT-INR), partial thromboplastin time (PTT), fibrinogen, antithrombin 111, D-dimer, APC resistance, protein C, protein 5, specific lymphocyte subpopulations of lymph and monocyte disorders (CD)

CARDIOLOGY

At Casa di Cura Eretenia special attention is devoted to heart diseases and patients may request specialist visits and admissions, with either NHS or private treatment.

Admitted** patients are treated for the following disorders:

- Cardiocirculatory failure
- Rhythm and conduction disorders
- Dilated cardiomyopathy
- Hypertrophic cardiomyopathy





- Restrictive cardiomyopathy
- Arrhythmogenic Right Ventricular Cardiomyopathy
- Congenital heart disease
- Acquired valve diseases
- Pericarditis
- High blood pressure and hypertensive heart disease
- Acute and chronic heart failure
- Thyrotoxic cardiomyopathy

GENERAL SURGERY

Surgery has a key role at Casa di Cura Eretenia. Through this division, a highly qualified staff and state-of-the-art technology, surgical procedures are conducted effectively and efficiently.

Our facility has a functional unit dedicated to all General Surgery procedures, from major surgery to minor day-care surgery (hernias, varicose veins, etc...). Our surgical activity is characterised by extensive use of advanced laparoscopy to treat all the disorders that can benefit from it (oncological surgery, obesity surgery, antireflux surgery). Major Surgery procedures are made possible through the use of advanced diagnostic equipment, a post-operative intensive care unit and the work of high qualified professionals (anaesthesiologists and radiologists) who ensure compliance with the highest safety standards. Minor surgeries and invasive diagnostic and therapeutic procedures with local and regional anaesthesia are performed on a same-day basis, meaning that patients can undergo

minor surgery or diagnostic procedures and go home the same day. The above surgical procedures can be performed on the NHS or privately.

ABDOMINAL WALL SURGERY

(hernias and laparoceles) Tension-free technique using a polypropylene mesh, according to Trabucco, Lichtenstein and Rives.

• LOWER LIMB VARICOSE VEINS

Targeted procedures according to recent studies on venous hemodynamics by Doppler ultrasound. Endovascular laser therapy can also be performed if indicated (private care only.)

COLOPROCTOLOGY

The Coloproctology Division offers both outpatient and surgical services.

A proctologic examination is key to accurate diagnosis and effective management of patients suffering from anus and rectal symptoms such as pain, bleeding, itching, tumefaction, purulent discharge, changes in bowel habits, etc.

Surgeries In-patient treatment ** Coloproctology Unit of Vicenza - S.I.U.C.P.

- Anal fissure (removal and left lateral internal sphincterotomy)
- Treatment of anal fistula and abscess (fistulectomy/fistulotomy, treatment of complex anal fistulas through sphincter saving techniques: fistula closure with "plugs" or by laser fibre or LIFT procedure)
- Treatment of constipation, anal pain and faecal incontinence with sacral nerve neurostimulators



- Removal of colon and rectal polyps with various methods
- Open and closed pilonidal sinus excision
- Haemorrhoid therapy:

Milligan-Morgan haemorrhoidectomy, mucous rectal prolapse using Longo muco-prolapsectomy with mechanical stapler, transanal haemorrhoidal dearterialisation with or without Doppler guidance and mucous pexis, Stapled Transanal Resection of the Rectum (STARR) with single or double stapling technique

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 Surgeries for the treatment of Constipation due to Obstructed Defecation Syndrome (ODS) and rectal prolapse: Stapled Transanal Resection of the Rectum (STARR) with single or double stapling technique, Delorme's procedure for rectal prolapse

UROLOGY AND ANDROLOGY

In-patient treatment **

GYNAECOLOGY

Surgeries Inpatient treatment **

Scheduled admissions for all types of gynaecological, laparotomic, vaginal, laparoscopic surgical procedures.

Surgeries are mainly performed with advanced laparoscopic techniques (oncological surgery, uterine and vaginal prolapse surgery, benign diseases).

OTOLARYNGOLOGY

This medical speciality covers the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the ear, nose and paranasal sinuses, throat and other related part of the head and neck.

Inpatient surgery **

- Adenoidectomy
- Tonsillectomy
- Tympanocentesis for catarrhal otitis
- Septoplasty, turbinoplasty and septoplasty with turbinoplasty





- Functional endoscopic sinus surgery (FESS) for nasal polyps and chronic sinusitis
- Diagnostic and surgical microlaryngoscopy for vocal cord disorders
- Uvulopalatoplasty for snoring
- Surgical removal of cysts, lymph nodes or other neoplasms in the neck
- Submandibular gland removal due to stones or neoplasms.
- Total or subtotal parotidectomy
- Partial or total thyroidectomy

Outpatient treatment

When indicated, the following diagnostic investigations can be performed during an ENT consultation:

- Hearing testing in sound proof booth
- Impedance test (tympanogram and acoustic reflex testing)
- Diagnostic and therapeutic otomicroscopy
- ENT Endoscopy (videorhinoscopy, fiberoptic laryngoscopy)
- Vestibular testing with positional manoeuvres for paroxysmal positional vertigo

OPHTHALMOLOGY

Surgery **

The Department of Orthopaedics covers and treats all musculoskeletal conditions multidisciplinary with а approach involving consultants, anaesthesiologists, neurologists, infectious disease specialists, surgeons, physical therapists innovative sophisticated and and diagnostic techniques.

Our department has rooms for ordinary admissions and beds for Outpatient/Day Surgery patients.

All rooms are equipped with air conditioning, private bathroom, TV and adjustable bed.

PHYSICAL MEDICINE AND REHABILITATION

The Physical Rehabilitation Medicine Service is oriented to the prevention, care and rehabilitation of patients' conditions, with the purpose to ensure full recovery and return to work, family life and social activities.

This Service has a ward with 10 beds covered by the NHS for orthopaedic trauma conditions and a rehabilitative physical medicine clinic (private treatment only).

Our Team provide outpatient customised rehabilitation programs, whose effectiveness is promoted by constant interaction between Physiatrist and Rehabilitation Therapists.

The services include:

• Orthopaedic rehabilitation

pre and post surgery (hip**, shoulder, elbow, wrist, knee, ankle, etc.)
post-traumatic (fractures, tendon ligament injuries, muscle damage, etc.)
sub-acute and chronic degenerative conditions (polyarthritis, spondylodiscarthrosis, coxarthrosis, gonarthrosis, subacromial impingement syndrome, frozen shoulder, etc.)



Sport rehabilitation

- after traumatic sports injuries (sprains, fractures, etc.)

- after overuse (tendinitis, bursitis, etc.) to enable the athlete to regain ability in competitive and non competitive sport activities.

- Children's developmental rehabilitation (flat foot, varus foot, varus metatarsus, scoliosis, kyphosis, kyphoscoliotic attitude).
- Physical therapy for seniors

- Postural Restoration exercises to improve postural symmetry, proprioception, self-correction and bodily self-awareness, and fix any postural imbalances and spinal misalignments.
- Physical rehabilitation exercise class
- Manual lymphatic drainage
- Therapeutic and sports massages
- Global postural **restoration**
- Active and passive mobilisation

Instrumental physiotherapy

AESTHETIC PLASTIC SURGERY OF HEAD AND FACE

• FACIAL IMPLANTS

They are used to augment and enhance specific areas of the face

DERMABRASION

Skin-resurfacing procedure to improve uneven skin

- LIPOMODELLING Fat grafting or fat transfer

Uro-Gynaecological Pelvic and Perineal Physiokinetic Therapy

Outpatient treatment

From a uro-gynaecological perspective, the treatment addresses various types of urinary incontinence (stress-urgemixed) and consists of a combination of functional electrical stimulation and pelvic floor exercises to strengthen and tone all pelvic floor muscles. Sessions of about 20 minutes (for 10-12 session treatments) are held two or three times a week with a qualified physical therapist under the supervision of the attending physician.

Patients are also offered the possibility of receiving an appropriate diagnostic procedure within a short time (urogynaecological examination, pad-test, video-urodynamics, cystoscopy, etc.) and any other more invasive treatment options where necessary.

Pelvic floor dysfunction may also involve faecal incontinence, constipation by functional outlet obstruction and anismus. After careful selection and assessment of patients, these conditions can be completely resolved using a pressure biofeedback unit or EMG with or without electrostimulation.

Food Science Nutritionist

A Nutritionist helps people who need to change their lifestyle to address their personal needs or specific health conditions, and therefore want to improve their relationship with themselves or their health and well-being, identifying the right nutrition and a healthy diet.

In particular:

- People suffering from malnutrition, overweight, obese and underweight people
- Patients suffering from diseases such as diabetes, hypercholesterolemia, hypertriglyceridemia, atherosclerosis, hypertension, cardio-circulatory disorders, intolerances or allergies
- Pre or post-surgical or oncological patients

The ideal diet is identified with a nutritional consultation

- During the first consultation (about one hour), the patients will be asked a few questions about current health, past medical history and eating habits. A thorough body composition analysis is then performed (using methods such as bioelectrical impedance analysis, anthropometry and plicometry) to define the patient's body composition, health status and energy needs.
- There will be a second consultation after a few days; the nutritionist will prepare a custom diet plan based on the data collected during the first meeting, which will be delivered to the patient together with a body composition analysis.

Follow-up visits visits will then be conducted to monitor the patient's progress and plan how to maintain the results achieved.

At discharge, the patients will receive a discharge report for their family physician.

Visitors must not interfere with the normal hospital operations or make sure they do not disturb other patients who may be resting.

For this reason, family and visitors must wait outside the room during patient rounds, medicine administration rounds or while the cleaning staff is inside. Please keep a quiet conversational volume in all inpatient wards.

Please note: children under 12 years of age are not permitted in patient care areas unless explicitly authorised, and only in selected cases, by the chief physician in charge of that area (Prime Ministerial Decree 19/05/1995).



Religious and Spiritual Care

Discharge

If you wanted to be discharged against medical advice, you will need to sign a specific written statement relieving the medical staff of any responsibility related to this decision or its consequences.



Morgue Service

Our facility includes a mortuary, which can be accessed through the inner courtyard.

Bodies are transferred to the morgue by our staff about two hours after death.

Please note that our staff is not authorised to provide any contact details and addresses of funeral homes. The choice of the funeral service provider must be made exclusively by family members, as they deem appropriate.

Health documents Medical Record

You may request a copy of your medical record by filling in the relevant form at the Admitting Office and by paying your fees in advance.

A copy will be made available within 7 days after your request, except in emergencies, and may be picked by you or by a person authorised in writing to collect your result on your behalf.

In case of incomplete medical records, any additions to your documentation will be issued within 30 days after your request.

The authorised persons must bring the following documents:

- A copy of the request form
- A letter of authorisation (on plain paper)
- A photocopy of the patient's identity document
- Their own ID



In the event of death, legitimate heirs may request to obtain the deceased person's medical records.
